In March of 2011, we started out on this journey together as a community searching for a way to impact the issue of human trafficking in Wichita. Five years later, we have a lot to celebrate!

Saturday, October 22nd we're planning to do just that. In addition to five years of ICT SOS we'll also mark five years of the Race 4 Freedom 5K which has supported five direct service partners, raising over \$100,000 — all of which was donated locally!

In five years, ICT SOS has created and distributed over 500 Fresh Start bags, provided prevention education for hundreds of students (612 so far in 2016 alone!), created awareness, trained volunteers and spearheaded some really great projects! We were instrumental in opening the OZ Homeless Youth drop-in center in partnership with Wichita Children's Home. We staged a "freeze-mob" on the Douglas Street bridge during Riverfest. We've hosted concerts, documentary screenings and speakers, including INK180 tattoo artist Chris Baker from Chicago. We have served on local and statewide task forces, including the U.S. Attorney's Human Trafficking Working Group. We have helped to create additional housing at Carpenter Place and a playground at the new Child Advocacy Center. And much more...

Funds raised at the event will support our programs as we continue to grow. **Tell Your Friends** is a trafficking prevention education program which provides curriculum in middle and high schools at no cost to the schools. **Fresh Start Bags** are duffel bags filled with clothing, hygiene and other supplies that we create for our local direct service professionals to provide to victims & survivors. **Next Step** is a six-session volunteer training program. This fall we will launch our first student-led Advisory Board. And one of the programs we're very excited to develop, with the guidance of INK180, is a trafficking tattoo removal and cover up service for referrals from our direct service partners. All of this growth will take place in our new home office at the brand new Child Advocacy Center!
